



# Alarm & CCTV Installation Course

## COURSE OVERVIEW

This course is designed to provide you with the knowledge and skills required to install and commission Closed Circuit TV (CCTV), install a basic alarm system from the sensors through to the alarm panel and control pad PLUS how to main complex alarm systems including back to base monitoring.

## COURSE ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Education – Successful completion of Year 10 or its equivalent (Proof required)
- White Card – A current Construction Induction certificate (NSW WorkCover White Card or equivalent from another State or Territory) (proof required)
- Language, Literacy and numeracy skills – A practical applied level of English and mathematics suitable for study of theory units.

## DURATION AND STRUCTURE

This course is delivered through a blended setup and is conducted in person, spanning up to 2 weeks. Your participation will involve attending the face-to-face session for a minimum of 16 hours, spread out over 4 nights scheduled from 5:00 PM to 9:00 PM.

During the course, you'll collaborate in small groups as well as work individually. To demonstrate competency, you'll undertake a range of assessments. These assessments encompass short-answer questions and Practical Activities.

## COURSE UNIT

This course constitutes 3 units of competency, listed below. Upon completion, you will be awarded a nationally accredited Statement of Attainment.

- **CPPSEC2021** – Install security equipment and systems
- **CPPSEC2026** – Perform routine maintenance on security equipment and systems
- **CPPSEC2023** – Install video surveillance systems and equipment

## The course encompasses the following topics:

### Alarm Installation

- Identifying and documenting security requirements
- Presenting specifications and configurations in line with client needs
- Programming security equipment and systems
- Installing security systems and equipment, including testing and fault-finding
- Commissioning and decommissioning security equipment and systems
- Preparing for, carrying out, and completing routine maintenance
- Coordinating the delivery of high-quality security services to clients, including estimates and quotes



### CCTV Installation

- Planning and coordinating installation of security equipment and systems
- Installing CCTV and audio systems
- Conducting diagnosis of faults
- Carrying out maintenance activities
- Carrying out service activities on security equipment and systems
- Adhering to and supporting OHS and risk control procedures
