

# Accredited Service Provider (ASP)

## Level 2 Pathways

### COURSE OVERVIEW

The ASP Level 2 Training Course is designed for qualified electrical and Electrical Supply Industry (ESI) workers seeking to gain the formal training required to perform contestable electrical network works under the NSW Accredited Service Provider (ASP) Scheme.

This course delivers nationally recognised units of competency aligned to ASP Level 2 classes (2A, 2B, 2C and/or 2D), depending on the pathway selected. Training focuses on developing the technical knowledge, practical skills, and safety awareness required to work on or near the electricity distribution network in accordance with current legislation, industry standards, and network operator requirements.

Training is delivered by experienced industry professionals with current, practical knowledge of the NSW ASP Scheme and electricity supply industry expectations.

**Important Notice:** Completion of this course does not automatically grant ASP accreditation. Accreditation and authorisation are managed separately under the NSW ASP Scheme Rules and relevant legislation.

### STRUCTURE & DURATION

- Blended delivery model (theory + practical)
- Structured classroom-based learning
- Hands-on practical training
- Assessment through theory questions and practical demonstrations
- Delivery schedules may vary depending on selected ASP Level 2 class pathway

**Mandatory Units + Class 2A Duration:** 3 full days

**Class 2B Duration:** 3 full days

**Class 2C Duration:** 4 full days

**Class 2D Duration:** 3 full days

**OH Services Mandatory Refresher Training Duration:** 1 full day

## Course Entry Requirements:

To enrol in the ASP Level 2 course, applicants must meet one of the following:

- Hold a current unrestricted electrical licence (Electrician) issued in Australia;  
OR
- Hold one of the following nationally recognised qualifications:
  - UEE30820 Certificate III in Electrotechnology Electrician
  - UET30821 Certificate III in ESI – Power Systems – Distribution Cable Jointing
  - UET30621 Certificate III in ESI Distribution – Overhead

## COURSE OUTCOMES

On successful completion of the ASP Level 2 training, participants will:

- Receive a Statement of Attainment for the relevant ASP Level 2 units completed
- Satisfy the formal training requirement under the NSW ASP Scheme Rules for the applicable Level 2 class/es
- Gain the knowledge and skills to safely perform contestable electrical network works within the trained scope
- Be eligible to use this training as supporting evidence when applying for ASP Level 2 accreditation (subject to meeting all additional requirements)

## Additional Requirements:

- Adequate Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) skills
- Adequate digital literacy skills
- Ability to safely participate in practical training and assessments

Final eligibility for ASP accreditation is determined by the NSW Government and relevant electricity network operators.

## MANDATORY UNITS (ALL CLASSES)

Required by all NSW Network Distributors (Ausgrid, Endeavour Energy & Essential Energy):

- HLTAID009 – Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
- UETDRMP007 – Perform rescue from a live low voltage panel
- UETDRMP010 – Provide first aid in an ESI environment
- CPCWHS1001 – Prepare to work safely in the construction industry



## ASP LEVEL 2 PATHWAYS

### Class 2A – Disconnect & Reconnect at the Point of Connection

#### Units of Competency

UETDRIS011 – Install and maintain low voltage underground services  
UETDRMP011 – Testing of connections to low voltage electricity networks

### Class 2B – Underground Services

#### Units of Competency

UETDRIS011 – Install and maintain low voltage underground services  
UETDRMP011 – Testing of connections to low voltage electricity networks

### Class 2C – Overhead Services

#### Units of Competency

UETDRIS010 – Install and maintain low voltage overhead services  
UETDRMP011 – Testing of connections to low voltage electricity networks

### Class 2D – Energising Service Equipment

#### Units of Competency

ETDRIS014 – Install and replace energy meters and associated equipment  
UETDRMP011 – Testing of connections to low voltage electricity networks

**Note:** Class 2D does **not** authorise ASPs to install meters.  
Refer to NSW ASP Scheme FAQs for clarification.

#### Units of Competency

UETDRMP006 – Perform pole top rescue  
UETDRMP004 – Perform Elevated Work Platform controlled descent escape  
UETDRMP005 – Perform Elevated Work Platform rescue
